Date	Day of Week	Days Before Election	Event
Jul 20	Sat	108	First day to file an application for a place on ballot.
Aug 19	Mon	78	Last day for ordering a General Election.
Aug 19	Mon	78	Last day to file for a place on the ballot for a General Election.
Aug 23	Fri	74	Last day to file Declaration of WRITE-IN candidacy.
Aug 23	Fri	74	Must post notice of ballot position drawing if drawing is to be held on Aug. 27.
Aug 26	Mon	71	Recommended first day that an election may be cancelled IF all filing deadlines have passed and each candidate whose name is to appear on the ballot is unopposed.
Aug 27	Tues	70	Last day to order a Special Election to fill a vacancy and have the filing deadline be the 62 nd day before Election Day. Please note Election Code requires the election to be ordered as soon as practicable after the vacancy occurs.
Aug 27	Tues	70	Recommended date to conduct ballot position drawing.
Aug 27	Tue	70	Entities must provide Order of Election and ballot language, including office titles, list of candidates in drawn order (including write-ins), pronunciation guide for all candidates, and ballot propositions. All ballot language must be in both English & Spanish.
Sept 3	Tues	63	Entities to provide Elections Office with hard copy of executed contract.
Sept 4	Wed	62	Last day to file for a place on the ballot in a Special Election to fill a vacancy, if the special election is ordered on or before the 70 th day before election day.
Sept 6	Fri	60	Elections Office will email drafts of paper ballots & approval forms to contracting entities.
Sept 11-12	Wed-Thurs	55-54	TENTATIVE Entities to approve Electronic ballot @ Elections Office. Final paper & electronic ballot approval forms due.
Sept 18-20	Wed-Fri	48-46	TENTATIVE Public Test of Voting Equipment 10am - 5pm.
Sept 21	Sat	45	Elections Office to begin mailing military and overseas mail ballots.
Sept 30	Mon	36	Elections Office to begin mailing domestic mail ballots.
Oct 4	Friday	32	Entities to provide any bond notices to be sent to the polling locations.
Oct 7	Mon	29	Last day to register to vote for the November 5, 2019 election.
Oct 21	Mon	15	First day for early voting by personal appearance.
Oct 25	Fri	11	Last day to receive application for a ballot to be voted by mail.
Nov 1	Fri	4	Last day for early voting by personal appearance (7am - 7pm).
Nov 2	Sat	3	Early Voting Ballot Board 9 am - 5 pm.
Nov 5	Tue	0	Election Day & Ballot Board at 12 pm.
Nov 6	Wed	1 day after	Deadline to receive late domestic mail ballots bearing a cancellation mark indicating 7pm, November 5, 2019 or earlier.
Nov 12	Tues	7 days after	Last day to receive ballots mailed from outside the U.S. on or before Election Day as well as ballots from domestic military voters who submitted a Federal Post Card Application.
Nov 12	Tues	7 days after	Deadline for ID provisional voter to "cure" provisional ballots.
Nov 13	Wed	8 days after	Provisional/Late Ballot Board 10am - 3pm.
Nov 14	Thurs	9 days after	Elections office will provide results reports to contracting entities for canvassing.
Nov 18	Mon	13 days after	Last day to canvass results.
